Nominate for your LOCAL AUTHORITY

What is a Local Authority?

A Local Authority is a group of people from your community who will make sure that people have a strong voice in their community. This group of people will make decisions of behalf of the community and talk to the Regional Council about these issues.

What does this mean for you and your community?

A strong Local Authority will make informed decisions on issues and get things done based on recommendations which come from within the local community.

How do you nominate?

For information about the nomination process and the nomination form, speak to your Regional Services Manager in your community. All community members are encouraged to nominate. Nominations are open from 28 September 2017 and close 25 October 2017.

What is the commitment?

Local Authority members meet four times a year, for the next four years (a full Council term).
