### **Who Can Apply?**

You can apply if you are:

- A community group or organisation
- An individual resident in West Arnhem

### **You (and your application) must:**

- Be based or reside in the West Arnhem Regional Council area
- Align with Council's Strategic Pillars and Annual Regional Plan
- Have no outstanding debts or reports owed to Council

### **What Can Be Funded?**

- Community events and festivals
- Youth programs and activities
- Sport and recreation initiatives
- Arts and cultural projects
- Community wellbeing programs
- Equipment for community activities



**Funds Available:**

The sponsorship pool will be shared between the most eligible applicants across all West Arnhem communities. Large claims (i.e. \$10,000) are not likely to be successful.

Applications close: 10am, Friday 27 March 2026

Outcomes notified after the Council has made its decisions: Around May 2026
